Scope and Content Note

The papers of Philipp Sarasin (1888-1968) span the years 1885-1968, with the bulk of the material dating from 1944 to 1966. The collection consists primarily of patient case files from Sarasin's psychoanalytic practice in Basel, Switzerland. Included are transcripts of sessions, testing information, background data, and related enclosures. The papers also contain a letter from Michael Balint to Sarasin. The collection is in German.
