Summary: The collection consists of two celestial charts published by National Geographic and seven tourist maps that depict locations in the Mid-Atlantic states, Brazil, Denmark, Finland, and Japan. Golderberg, the compiler, had a career as a lawyer, associate justice of the United States Supreme Court, secretary of labor, and United States representative to the United Nations.

Biographical Note

Goldberg's served as secretary of labor in the administration of John F. Kennedy, associate justice in the U.S. Supreme Court, and U.S. ambassador to the United Nations; he operated a law practice in New York, N.Y., and Washington, D.C.; and served as chairman of the U.S. delegation to the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe, Belgrade, Yugoslavia, 1977-1978. In World War II, he worked with the U.S. Office of Strategic Services.
