**Summary:** The collection consists of 17 maps transferred from the G.E. Mueller papers, 1876-2012. Mueller collected tourist, road, and air route maps published between 1952 and 1983. Most maps show locations in Central America; other maps depict places in the United States and Europe. Mueller was an engineer, administrator of U.S. manned space flight program, and corporate executive.

## Processing History

The collection was processed and arranged by Ryan Moore in 2021.

## Transfers

The maps were transferred in February of 2002 from the G.E. Mueller papers, 1876-2012, a collection held in the Manuscript Collection of the Library of Congress.
