Biographical Note

Gwen Verdon (1925-2000) was a musical theater dancer, actor, and choreographer. Bob Fosse (1927-1987) was a dancer, choreographer, director, and producer. Verdon and Fosse became collaborators in 1955 when they met on the set of *Damn Yankees*. In 1960, they were married until Fosse's death.

Scope and Content Note

The collection spans the dates of 1949-1987 and contains photocopies of promotional materials from Bob Fosse productions.
