Summary: Ernst Kris, psychoanalyst, educator, and art historian; and Marianne Kris, physician and psychoanalyst.

Correspondence, writings, lecture notes, newspaper clippings, biographical material, photographs, and printed matter chiefly documenting the Krises' careers in psychoanalysis after their immigration to the United States in 1940. Material in digital format includes interviews and video footage.

The papers of Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris were given to the Library of Congress by Anton O. Kris and Anna Kris Wolff in 2001. Additions were given by Anton O. Kris in 2009 and by David S. Kris and Michael M. Kris in 2022.

Processing History

Part I of the papers of Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris were arranged and described in 2003 by Michael Spangler. Part II was processed and the finding aid revised in 2024 by Andrea J. Briggs with the assistance of Shandra Morehouse.

Digital files were received as part of the Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris Papers on a variety of storage media, each of which was assigned a unique digital ID number. Technical Requirements

Digital files were created in a Windows operating system, version unknown. The content is primarily audio files in .mp3 and .cda formats, moving image files in .mp4 format, and images in .jpg/.jpeg format. Files originally received in .cda format have been converted to .wav format for preservation and accessibility. Disk images were also created of media containing .vob moving image files for preservation and accessibility.

Scope and Content Note

The papers of Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris span the years 1872-2018, with the bulk of the material dating from 1940 to 1980. The collection consists of two parts. Part I documents the work of Ernst Kris as an educator, psychoanalyst, and author of works on psychoanalytic theory. Part II focuses primarily on the work of Marianne Kris as a psychoanalyst and educator. Both parts include material documenting the Krises' relationships with psychoanalytic colleagues, including Anna Freud, as well as material related to their immediate and extended families. Further descriptions of each part follow.

Part I

Part I of the Kris Papers spans the years 1893-1999, with the bulk of the material concentrated in the period 1940-1956. It documents Ernst Kris's activities as an educator, psychoanalyst, and author of works on psychoanalytic theory, and focuses primarily on the years following his move to New York in 1940 after emigrating from Austria. Part I includes no patient case files except for one case history that is closed, and very little relates to Ernst Kris's early career in art history in Vienna. The material is in English and German and is organized in six series: [Family Correspondence](#), [General Correspondence](#), [Speeches and Writings File](#), [Miscellany](#), [Closed](#), and [Oversize](#).

The [Speeches and Writings File](#) contains reprints of articles and reviews together with typed and handwritten drafts, lecture notes, transcripts of discussion groups, and ancillary material documenting most of Ernst Kris's professional career.

The [Miscellany](#) series contains awards, biographical material, clippings, immigration and citizenship records, printed matter, and material related to Ernst Kris's professional appointments and memberships.

The remaining series contain [Closed](#) and [Oversize](#) material.

Part II

Part II of the Kris Papers spans the years 1872-2018, with the bulk of the material concentrated between the years 1940 and 1980. It documents Marianne Kris's work as a psychoanalyst and educator, and focuses primarily on the years following her move to New York in 1940 after emigrating from Austria. A limited amount of material regarding Ernst Kris, particularly his early German-language art history publications, is also present in Part II. The papers include no patient case files; however, material containing potentially sensitive patient information has been removed to a [Closed](#) series. Some digital material is present throughout Part II and has been described in place. The papers are primarily in English, with some material in German, and is organized in eight series: [Correspondence](#), [Family Papers](#), [Personal File](#), [Photographs](#), [Speeches and Writings](#), [Subject File](#), [Closed](#), and [Oversize](#).

The series in Part II are listed and briefly described below. A fuller description of each series and a list of its contents can be accessed in the series descriptions within the container list.

The [Correspondence](#) series comprises personal and professional correspondence with Marianne Kris's colleagues, friends, and patients.

The [Family Papers](#) series primarily consists of correspondence with members of the Kris, Rie, Bondy, and Nunberg families, as well as miscellany belonging to individual family members.

The [Personal File](#) predominantly contains biographical material that provides an overview of Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris's lives and careers.

The [Photographs](#) series contains a mix of candid snapshots and formal portraits of members of the Kris, Rie, and Freud families, as well as friends and colleagues of Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris, chiefly other prominent psychoanalysts.

The [Speeches and Writings File](#) contains material relating to the professional career of Ernst Kris as an art historian and later as a psychoanalyst, and of Marianne Kris's work in child psychoanalysis and as a psychoanalytic educator.

The [Subject File](#) contains material related to Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris's professional appointments, interests, memberships, and affiliations; printed matter; and other miscellany.

The Family Correspondence series contains letters to and from Kris family members. See the Closed series.

BOX 1-14

Part I: General Correspondence, 1893-1975

The General Correspondence series includes letters exchanged with professional colleagues, students, institutional organizations, and friends that document Ernst Kris's role in the organization of group research projects, academic work, research, and publications. Originally trained in art history, Ernst Kris developed an interest in psychoanalysis through his wife, Marianne Kris, a psychoanalyst and friend of Sigmund Freud. He served as a training analyst at the Institute of Psychoanalysis in Vienna and published works on psychoanalytic theory, the creative mind, and art by people with mental health conditions. In 1938, Ernst Kris left Austria with Freud and other associates for London where he organized a program for the British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) to monitor and analyze Nazi propaganda broadcasts. After briefly working on a similar task at the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) in Montreal, he settled permanently in New York City, where he served as codirector of the analogous Research Project on Totalitarian Communication. Correspondence with Mark A. Abrams, John Scarlett Alexander Salt, and others in the British Broadcasting files pertains to events in England and Ernst Kris's work in Montreal and New York during World War II and includes many personal war stories. Letters exchanged with Anna Freud and Princess Marie Bonaparte relate mostly to the publication of Sigmund Freud's letters to Wilhelm Fliess in *The Origins of Psychoanalysis* in 1954. Other widely dispersed members of the Viennese psychoanalytic community are also represented in the correspondence. Letters exchanged with art historian Ernst H. Gombrich, with whom Ernst Kris worked on several occasions, reflect his continuing interest in art and the creative process. Organization and planning of projects for the study of infant development and gifted adolescents are documented in the Arthur Davison Ficke Foundation file, and Ernst Kris's teaching career is documented in files for the College of the City of New York and the New School for Social Research. Notable correspondents include Siegfried Bernfeld and Suzanne Cassirer Bernfeld, Gertrud Bing, Felix Deutsch and Helene Deutsch, K. R. Eissler and Ruth Selke Eissler, Otto Fenichel, Gladys Ficke, Edward Glover, Phyllis Greenacre, Heinz Hartmann, Willi Hoffer, Ernest Jones, Lawrence S. Kubie, Nathan Constantin Leites, Sándor Lorand, Thomas Mann, Enid McLeod, Margaret Mead, David Rapaport, Hanns Sachs, Raymond de Saussure, Milton J. E. Senn, Hans Speier, René A. Spitz, Lionel Trilling, and Sir John Wheeler Wheeler-Bennett.

BOX 15-21

Part I: Speeches and Writings File, 1900-1996

The Speeches and Writings File contains reprints of articles and reviews together with typed and handwritten drafts, lecture notes, transcripts of discussion groups, and ancillary material documenting most of Ernst Kris's professional career. Articles and reviews pertain to his early career as associate curator at the Kunsthistorisches Museum in Vienna in the 1920s and 1930s, and many of the writings reflect the intersection of Ernst Kris's two areas of study. The books file includes a typed draft of an unpublished work "Caricature: an Essay on Its History and Meaning," which Ernst Kris co-authored with art historian Ernst H. Gombrich, and material related to *The Origins of Psychoanalysis* which complements the correspondence of Anna Freud and Princess Marie Bonaparte. Research papers issued by the Research Project on Totalitarian Communication relating to psychological analysis

of Nazi broadcast propaganda during World War II were funded by the Rockefeller Foundation. A collaborative effort with numerous members, the project was codirected by Ernst Kris and Hans Speier and resulted in the publication of *German Radio Propaganda* in 1944.

Material types include printed, typed, and holograph copies of articles; bibliographies; books; discussion transcripts; lecture notes; research papers; and reviews; together with notes, correspondence, and ancillary material.

Part I: Miscellany, 1900-1999

The Miscellany series contains awards, biographical material, clippings, immigration and citizenship records, obituaries, memorials, printed matter, and material related to professional appointments and memberships.

Part I: Closed, 1940-1967

The Closed series contains material which may contain sensitive personal or patient information. It consists of family correspondence and a case history.

Part I: Oversize, 1937

The Oversize series contains items separated from their original locations due to size. Consists of an award.

BOX 24-48

Part II: Correspondence, 1923-1989

The Correspondence series comprises personal and professional correspondence with Marianne Kris's colleagues, friends, and patients, primarily from after her immigration to America in 1940 to her death in 1980. The correspondence touches on many aspects of Marianne Kris's life and career, including her work as a psychoanalyst in private practice as well as a consultant and educator with various professional institutions and organizations.

Letters exchanged with Anna Freud and Dorothy T. Burlingham are chiefly concerned with their personal lives and not their professional activities. Many letters with European correspondents are in German, although most other correspondence is in English. This series does not represent the entirety of correspondence in Part II as letters are found throughout other series, especially the Family Papers series and the Subject File. Notable correspondents include Grete L. Bibring, Dorothy T. Burlingham, K. R. Eissler, Anna Freud, Elisabeth R. Geleerd, Ernst H. Gombrich, Ilse Gombrich, Marjorie Harley, Heinz Hartmann, Jeanne Lampl-de-Groot, Anna Maenchen, Elisabeth Neumann-Viertel, Allan Roos, Beatrice M. Roos, Max Schur, Albert J. Solnit, Diana Trilling, and Lionel Trilling.

Material types include letters, greeting cards, telegrams, postcards, and photographs.

BOX 48-55

Part II: Family Papers, 1872-2018

The Family Papers series primarily consists of correspondence with members of the Kris, Rie, Bondy, and Nunberg families, and also contains miscellany belonging to individual family members. A folder of family trees documents the extensive relationships between different branches of the Kris and Rie families. Material from Anton O. Kris and Anna Kris Wolff includes correspondence with their parents, Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris, as well as some of their general correspondence. Also included with Anna Kris Wolff's papers are two oral

history transcripts, one with Ralph Gifford and Paul Gifford about their family memories and father, Sanford Gifford; and another by Anna Kris Wolff about her own memories with the Kris family.

Material types include correspondence, personal documents and other biographical material, oral history transcripts, sketchbooks, a cookbook, a travel diary, printed matter, and photographs.

BOX 55-58

Part II: Personal File, 1900-2009

The Personal File predominantly contains biographical material that provides an overview of Ernst Kris and Marianne Kris's lives and careers. It includes awards, certificates and licenses, curricula vitae, identification and immigration documents, household and estate records, material relating to their deaths, and miscellany. Of note is a transcript of an interview with Marianne Kris, conducted in 1980 by sociologist and psychoanalyst Nancy Chodorow, in which Kris discusses her background and career, her relationship with other contemporary psychoanalysts, and the role of women in the field of psychoanalysis.

Material types include correspondence, awards and certificates, curricula vitae, academic records, personal documents, clippings, printed matter, and interviews and transcripts; two interviews are in digital format.

BOX 58-63, 74

Part II: Photographs, 1876-2001

The Photographs series contains a mix of candid snapshots and formal portraits of members of the Kris, Rie, and Freud families, as well as the Krises' friends and colleagues, chiefly other prominent psychoanalysts. There are a significant number of photographs of Ernst Kris, Marianne Kris, and Anna Freud, both individually and with others at public and private events and gatherings. Dorothy T. Burlingham is featured most often in photographs related to Anna Freud. This series also contains digitized footage of Sigmund Freud's 100th Birthday Celebration in London, England, originally recorded in 1956 on 8mm film, along with digitized still images of the event. Part II: Speeches and Writings File, 1922-2005

The Speeches and Writings File contains material relating to the professional career of Ernst Kris as an art historian and later as a psychoanalyst, and of Marianne Kris's work in child psychoanalysis and as a psychoanalytic educator. The series consists of reprints and drafts of articles, essays, lectures, and speeches; transcripts of discussion groups; exhibition catalogs; and book reviews. Works produced by or related to Marianne Kris are arranged chronologically; works produced by or related to Ernst Kris are arranged first by material type and then chronologically to reflect their arrangement in Part I. In 1938, Ernst Kris left Austria with Freud and other associates for London where he organized a program for the British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) to monitor and analyze Nazi propaganda broadcasts. After briefly working on a similar task at the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) in Montreal, he settled permanently in New York City, where he served as codirector of the analogous Research Project on Totalitarian Communication. Correspondence with Mark A. Abrams, John Scarlett Alexander Salt, and others in the British Broadcasting files pertains to events in England and Ernst Kris's work in Montreal and New York during World War II and includes many personal war stories. Letters exchanged with Anna Freud and Princess Marie Bonaparte relate mostly to the publication of Sigmund Freud's letters to Wilhelm Fliess in <i>The Origins of Psychoanalysis</i> in 1954. Other widely dispersed members of the Viennese psychoanalytic community are also represented in the correspondence. Letters exchanged with art historian Ernst H. Gombrich, with whom Ernst Kris worked on several occasions, reflect his continuing interest in art and the creative process. Organization and planning of projects for the study of infant development and gifted adolescents are documented in the Arthur Davison Ficke Foundation file, and Ernst Kris's teaching career is documented in files for the College of the City of New York and the New School for Social Research. The [Speeches and Writings File](#) contains reprints of articles and reviews together with typed and handwritten drafts, lecture notes, transcripts of discussion groups, and ancillary material documenting most of Ernst Kris's professional career. Articles and reviews pertain to his early career as associate curator at the Kunsthistorisches Museum in Vienna in the 1920s and 1930s, and many of the writings reflect the intersection of Ernst Kris's two areas of study. The books file includes a typed draft of an unpublished work "Caricature: an Essay on Its History and Meaning," which Ernst Kris co-authored with art historian Ernst H. Gombrich, and material related to *The Origins of Psychoanalysis* which complements the correspondence of Anna Freud and Princess Marie Bonaparte. Research papers issued by the Research Project on Totalitarian Communication relating to psychological analysis of Nazi broadcast propaganda during World War II were funded by the Rockefeller Foundation. A collaborative effort with numerous members, the project was codirected by Ernst Kris and Hans Speier and resulted in the publication of *German Radio Propaganda* in 1944.

Material types include printed, typed, and holograph copies of articles; bibliographies; books; discussion transcripts; lecture notes; research papers; and reviews; together with notes, correspondence, and ancillary material.

The Speeches and Writings File contains material relating to the professional career of Ernst Kris as an art historian and later as a psychoanalyst, and of Marianne Kris's work in child psychoanalysis and as a psychoanalytic educator. The series consists of reprints and drafts of articles, essays, lectures, and speeches; transcripts of discussion groups; exhibition catalogs; and book reviews.
