**Summary:** Studio and gallery facility dedicated to teaching and promoting the art of printmaking and related crafts, founded by African-American printmaker Robert Hamilton Blackburn in 1948. General office files, printmaking exhibition files, correspondence, print listings and catalogs, financial records, subject files, publicity material, photographs, receipts, printed matter, and miscellaneous material.

The records of the Printmaking Workshop were transferred to the Manuscript Division from the Prints and Photographs Division in 2007. The records are a gift to the Library of Congress from the Printmaking Workshop, part of an agreement that included a purchase by the Library of Congress of prints from the studio in 2000.

Paper records in the Printmaking Workshop collection were processed in 2012. Born-digital files were organized and described in 2015.

## **Organizational History**

The Printmaking Workshop was founded in New York, N.Y., in 1948 by African-American artist and printmaker Robert Hamilton Blackburn (1920-2003) to provide studio and gallery space, equipment, and instruction in printmaking and allied crafts to aspiring and experienced printmakers.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The Printmaking Workshop is an ongoing New York City nonprofit organization and artists' cooperative founded by African-American artist and master printmaker Robert Hamilton Blackburn (1920-2003) in 1948 to provide studio space, equipment, instruction, gallery space, and community to artists in the printmaking and related fields. The collection spans the years 1979-1997, with the bulk concentrated in the period 1987-1997. The material consists of office files, material relating to exhibitions, correspondence, print listings and catalogs, financial records, subject files, publicity material, photographs, receipts, and printed matter. The records are organized into three series: Exibitions and Other Events, General Office File, and Digital File.

The <u>Exhibitions and Other Events</u> series documents exhibits, auctions, and benefits held at the Printmaking Workshop's own gallery and in other venues in the United States and across the world.

The General Office File documents the administration and operations of the organization from the 1970s into the late 1990s.
