## Organizational History

The Council on Library Information and Resources (CLIR) was created through a merger of the Council on Library Resources and the Commission on Preservation and Access in 1997.

The Council on Library Resources was established in 1956 through a grant funded by the Ford Foundation and under the leadership of the organization's first president, Verner W. Clapp. Charged as an independent coordinating agency, the Council's original mission was to address common issues faced by libraries in an era marked by library growth and the development of new technologies. Early programs focused largely on academic libraries and emphasized research, technological development, bibliographic control, and paper preservation.

The Commission on Preservation and Access was established in 1986 as a result of a task force organized to examine the problem of deteriorating materials in academic libraries and to develop a plan for collective action. Under the leadership of Patricia Battin, the organization originally focused on preserving analog material through microfilming projects in research libraries. Later, the Commission shifted its attention to that of born digital materials and in 1994, worked with the National Archives and Records Administration and the Library of Congress to establish the Digital Library Federation.

In order to streamline efforts and better utilize funds, a merger of the Council and the Commission was initiated in 1995, with Deanna Marcum appointed as president of both organizations. The merger was completed in 1997 with the creation of the Council on Library and Information Resources.

## Scope and Content Note

The Council on Library and Information Resources Records span the years 1937 to 2001, with the bulk of the material dating between 1956 and 1980. The collection is organized into six series: [Administrative File](#), [President's Files](#), [Correspondence](#), [Projects](#), [Subject File](#), and [Oversize](#).

This collection focuses on the functions of the Council on Library Resources, one of two organizations that merged to form the Council on Library and Information Resources (CLIR) in 1997. The vast majority of these records chronicle the operations, projects, and activities of the Council on Library Resources from its founding in 1956 until 1980, with heavy emphasis on the organization's work in the field of book and paper preservation. Represented to a minimal extent are records related to the mission and activities of the Commission on Preservation and Access, the second organization from which CLIR was formed. Evidence of the merge itself and of CLIR's operations and pursuits afterward are also minimally documented.

Where possible, a distinction was made between projects and endeavors of the Council on Library Resources, Commission on Preservation and Access and CLIR, though in some cases, the researcher will have to refer to the records to determine by which entity work was conducted.

The [Administrative File](#) chronicles the Council on Library Resources' establishment and early operations with material dating between 1955 and 1996. A chronological file forms the bulk of this series and includes founding documents, by-laws, annual reports, Board of Directors meeting minutes, Executive Committee meeting minutes, and project proposals. Also included are internal memoranda between organizational leaders, planning documents, organizational histories, press releases and some publications. No files documenting the administration of the Commission on Preservation and Access or CLIR are included in this series.

The [President's Files](#) contain material associated with past presidents of the Council on Library Resources, Commission on Preservation and Access, and CLIR with dates ranging between 1937 and 2001. Included in this series are documents created or collected by Verner W. Clapp, president of the Council on Library Resources from 1956 until 1967, Patricia Battin, president of Commission on Preservation and Access from 1987 until 1994, and Deanna B. Marcum, president of Council on Library Resources, and later CLIR from 1995 until 2003. This series chronicles speeches and remarks, articles, reports, and research material and primarily documents professional and scholarly pursuits related to the study of information and library science, but not necessarily associated with responsibilities of organizational leadership.

The [Correspondence](#) file comprises letters sent and received by CLIR and its originating organizations between 1956 and 2000 and is organized into two subseries. The [Alphabetical](#) subseries comprises incoming and outgoing letters associated with the Council on Library Resources exclusively. The [Chronological](#) subseries primarily represents outgoing correspondence from the Council on Library Resources, but also includes some correspondence, board reports, and press releases created by the Commission on Preservation and Access in the mid-1990s and outgoing letters from CLIR dating between 1997 and 2000.

The [Projects](#) series comprises records detailing projects funded through grant awards given by or to CLIR and range in date from 1955 to 1999. The series is organized into three subseries representing major projects comprised within. The [W.J. Barrow Research Laboratory](#) subseries documents various studies into paper preservation funded by the Council on Library Resources from 1957 until 1977. The [W.K. Kellogg Foundation](#) subseries chronicles a grant awarded to CLIR to participate in their Human Resources for Information Systems Management (HRISM) program from 1994 to 1997. The [General](#) subseries comprises grant listings and indices, funding information and sources, and smaller projects funded by CLIR.

The [Subject File](#) comprises material related to a variety of topics pertaining to library operations and administration, librarianship, and preservation and date between 1957 and 1996. Subjects include microfilming, copyright, access, library education, and professional organizations such as the Association of Research Libraries, National Association of Government Archives and Records Administrators, and the Coalition for Public Library Research.

#### Administrative File, 1955-1996

Memoranda, correspondence, meeting minutes, board reports, funding reports, and press releases detailing the Council of Library Resources founding, operations, and activities. Of particular note is series of memoranda from Vice-President Melville Ruggles and Program Officer Carl Spaulding to President Verner W. Clapp that dates between 1956 and 1966. This material details office procedures, pending projects and proposals, travel logs, and meeting notes, among other topics. Also included in this series are materials documenting funding sources, long range planning, organizational summaries and histories, and publications. A press release file reflects major projects, achievements, and milestones reached by the Council on Library Resources between 1957 and 1995.

#### President's Files, 1937-2001

Articles, speech transcripts, reports, and correspondence created or collected by past presidents of CLIR and its originating organizations. Represented individuals include Verner W. Clapp, Patricia Battin, and Deanna B. Marcum. The Clapp files comprise articles authored by Clapp, W. J. Barrow, Lee Edmonds Grove, and the National Bureau of Standards, and files pertaining to Clapp's death, memorial services, tributes, and affairs. The Battin files primarily document her various speaking engagements and authored articles between 1979 and 2001. Project files, awards, and records related to her tenure at Columbia University is also included. The Marcum files comprise authored articles, newsletters and reports created by the Commission on Preservation and Access and the Council on Library Resources in the years prior to the merge. Some material reflecting presentations is also included, as are research files and drafts for her dissertation. Little to no evidence exists in Marcum's files detailing the Council and Commission's merger, her role as the manager of the merge, or her responsibilities as president of the newly combined organizations.

#### Chronological, 1966-2000

Copies of outgoing letters primarily from Verner W. Clapp and Fred Cole that spans between 1966 and 2000, with a sizeable gap in records between 1981 and 1993. The period between 1966 and 1980 represent letters sent by the Council on Library Resources. The years 1994-1997 include correspondence, press releases, and Board of Directors reports

from both the Council on Library Resources and the Commission on Preservation and Access. The years after the merger, 1997 through 2000, represent letters sent by CLIR. Arranged chronologically.

**Projects, 1955-1999**

Records detailing grant funded projects awarded by or to CLIR and its originating organizations. The W.J. Barrow Laboratory records document a series of grants issued by the Council on Library Resources to study paper deterioration and other paper preservation issues over the period from 1957 to 1977. The W.K. Kellogg Foundation records document a grant awarded to CLIR to participate in the Foundation's Human Resources for Information Systems Management (HRISM) program from 1994 to 1997. The General records comprise grant listings and indices, funding information and sources, and smaller projects funded by CLIR.

**W.J. Barrow Research Laboratory, 1957-1987**

Progress reports, correspondence, grant applications, financial reports, and articles reflecting a series of grants funded by the Council on Library Resources to the Laboratory for the study of paper deterioration between 1957 and 1977. Initially, the Council issued grants to the Virginia State Library for specific studies performed in part by W.J. Barrow. In 1961, the Council funded a grant to establish the W.J. Barrow Laboratory and subsequently funded the Laboratory's operations through additional grants until 1977 when funding ceased. The results of these studies were published in a book series titled *Permanence/Durability of the Book*. These files primarily relate to funding matters and financial reporting, but also include correspondence, progress reports for the various *Permanence/Durability of the Book* studies, patent applications and related correspondence, and in the 1970s, minutes, reports, and correspondence of a review group established by the Council to examine the utility of the Laboratory.

**W.K. Kellogg Foundation, 1977-1999**

Correspondence, printed matter, reports, meeting agendas, notes, and handouts chronicling a three year grant awarded to CLIR in 1994 as part of the Foundation's program for Human Resources for Information Systems Management (HRISM). Through this program, CLIR organized workshops, meeting series, and case studies focused on developing leaders, building networks within the library and information science community, and strengthening the dialogue among the many parties that use and support public libraries. This file contains Advisory Council minutes, minutes and handouts for a series of networking meetings hosted by CLIR, program summaries, reports, budget documents, project evaluations, planning and strategy meeting materials. Also included are files pertaining to the projects and outcomes from other grant recipients and material related to a case study CLIR organized examining innovative uses of technology in public libraries across the United States. To a minimal extent, material concerning projects funded by the Foundation prior to the HRISM initiative is included and span the years between 1977 and 1993.

The results of these studies were published in a book series titled <i>Permanence/Durability of the Book</i> . These files primarily relate to funding matters and financial reporting, but also include correspondence, progress reports for the various <i>Permanence/Durability of the Book</i> studies, patent applications and related correspondence, and in the 1970s, minutes, reports, and correspondence of a review group established by the Council to examine the utility of the Laboratory.
