## Scope and Content Note

The papers of Helen Thomas span the years 1929 to 2013, with the bulk of the material dating between 1980 and 2005. The papers are organized into the following series: [White House Press Corps](#), [Speeches and Events](#), [Writings](#), [Personal File](#), [Correspondence](#), [Digital Files](#), and [Oversize](#).

The collection documents Thomas's career as a journalist in the White House press corps and chronicles her coverage of American presidents and first families across ten presidential administrations. These papers are composed primarily of documents Thomas collected in the course of her work as a White House correspondent and bureau chief and as an active member of many professional organizations. To a lesser extent, these papers reflect Thomas's opinions of American politics and presidents and her contributions to the field of journalism, especially with regard to expanding the profession for female journalists. Evidence of Thomas's celebrity and wide recognition within the profession and among the greater public can be found throughout the collection.

The [White House Press Corps](#) series comprises material related to Thomas's work in the White House press corps and spans the years 1929 to 2012. The bulk of the material dates between 1977 and 1997. This series is organized chronologically by presidential administration, with the Carter, Reagan, and Clinton administrations the most heavily documented. Materials related to the Kennedy, Johnson, Nixon, Ford, George H.W. Bush., and George W. Bush administrations are also included. Little to no evidence of the Obama administration is found in this collection, although Thomas did cover it during her career. Material Thomas collected from various events hosted by the White House or first ladies, press conferences, and trips with presidents and aboard *Air Force One* comprise the bulk of this series.

The [Speeches and Events](#) file documents the many public appearances, lectures, and award ceremonies in which Thomas participated between 1960 and 2013. Documentation of the many honors and honorary degrees bestowed upon Thomas are contained in this series, as are scripts and programs from the Gridiron Club's annual dinners. Copies of speeches delivered by Thomas are also included, though they are often fragmented and undated. Few complete copies of remarks appear in these files.

The [Writings](#) file contains copies of Thomas's newspaper articles and to a smaller degree, material related to some of her books. Dates in this series span between 1960 and 2011, with the bulk of the material dating between 2000 and 2008, at which time Thomas worked as a columnist for Hearst Newspapers. Thomas's 1999 book *Front Row at the White House: My Life and Times* and 2006 title, *Watchdogs of Democracy? : The Waning Washington Press Corps and How It Has Failed the Public* are the two most documented of her books.

The [Personal File](#) contains material related to Thomas's life and work between the years 1938 and 2013. This series includes an extensive collection of photographs chronicling Thomas's career in the White House press corps and her many speaking engagements. Newspaper articles about Thomas form another significant portion of this series. Material related to Thomas's marriage and husband, Douglas B. Cornell, a White House correspondent for the Associated Press, is also included.

The [Correspondence](#) series is comprised primarily of incoming letters sent to Thomas by friends, family, colleagues, and presidents and first ladies, dating between 1959 and 2013. Topics addressed in the letters are largely professional in nature, though the series includes some notes from Thomas's siblings and nieces and nephews. Several letters from Pauline Philips, also known as the advice columnist "Dear Abby" can also be found in this series.

The [Digital File](#) series includes audio, video, and image files removed from compact discs associated with Thomas's papers. This series is composed primarily of audio and video files, which feature interviews Thomas conducted and speeches Thomas gave at various events. Dates range from 2002 to 2010 and include several years of Gridiron Club dinners and performances.

Material related to Thomas's tenure in the White House press corps. The series primarily consists of programs, invitations, press releases, and printed matter collected by Thomas in the course of her work. Initially, Thomas covered "women's news" and focused on first ladies, first families, and social events. This is reflected by numerous files related to White House events and the weddings and children of Luci and Lynda Johnson and Tricia Nixon, for whom Thomas threw a bridal shower. Material from later in her career often includes itineraries and briefings from international trips taken by presidents and press releases from White House press secretaries, some of which bear notes written by Thomas. Articles, tear sheets, and notebooks are also found in this series, as is an extensive file of Thomas's press passes. Of particular note are files concerning Martha Mitchell, which include a book outline and other writings by Thomas. Correspondence sent to Mitchell, care of Thomas, is located in the [Correspondence](#) series. Photographs associated with presidents and first ladies are located in the [Personal File](#), and additional articles authored by Thomas are held in the [Writings](#) series.

**Speeches and Events, 1960-2013**

Material documenting events at which Thomas was honored, served as a speaker, or attended. Functions represented in this series are largely related to the many professional associations of which Thomas was a member and include the National Press Club, White House Correspondents' Association, Women's National Press Club, Washington Press Club Foundation, and especially, the Gridiron Club. Remarks and lectures delivered by Thomas form a large part of this series, though they are often undated and incomplete. Where possible, complete speeches were dated and filed chronologically. Programs, schedules, and logistic material related to the events at which Thomas spoke are sometimes included. Scripts, programs and invitations from annual Gridiron Club dinners are contained in this series, as are documents reflecting the many honors, awards, and honorary degrees bestowed upon Thomas. Photographs, clippings, and the program associated with Thomas's winning of the National Press Club's Fourth Estate Award and material documenting her election as the first female president of the Gridiron Club are also included in this series. For video and audio files depicting Thomas at various events, including Gridiron Club dinners, researchers should consult the digital files.

**Writings, 1960-2011**

Articles and material related to books authored by Thomas. Copies of Thomas's many newspaper articles comprise the bulk of this series. Articles date between 1960 and 2011, though the vast majority range between 2000 and 2011, when Thomas worked as a columnist for Hearst Newspapers. Material concerning books usually include proposals and drafts. Thomas's 2006 publication *Watchdogs of Democracy? : The Waning Washington Press Corps and How It Has Failed the Public* is the most comprehensively documented titled, followed by *Front Row at the White House: My Life and Times*. In some cases, only promotional material related to a publication is included. Not all of Thomas's books are chronicled in this collection.

**Personal File, 1938-2013**

Material related to Thomas's life and work. Photographs form a significant portion of this series and include images related to all ten presidential administrations covered by Thomas. Many of the photographs feature Thomas in her capacity in the White House press corps and feature her in the White House, at press conferences, aboard *Air Force One*, and with presidents and first ladies. Several photographs depict Thomas speaking at events and at Gridiron Club dinners. Photographs from Thomas's wedding to Douglas B. Cornell are also included. An extensive file of newspaper and magazine articles about Thomas is included in this series, as are transcripts of interviews Thomas gave. Biographical material, autobiographical material, and documents related to Thomas's death and funeral can also be found in this series. Researchers should note audio and video files of interviews given by Thomas can be found in the digital files.

Correspondence from presidents and first ladies are also included in this series.

**Digital File, 2002-2010**

Video, audio, and image files featuring Thomas delivering speeches, giving interviews, appearing in documentaries, and performing at Gridiron Club dinners. The majority of the interviews included in these files feature Thomas as the interviewee, with the exception of a series of audio files featuring interviews Thomas conducted with female senators for Melinda Mara's book *Changing the Face of Power: Women in the U.S. Senate*. Video files of the HBO documentary profile of Thomas, *Thank You, Mr. President: Helen Thomas at the White House*, directed by Rory Kennedy is also contained in this series. Files documenting a release event and panel discussion at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. accompany the documentary. Gridiron Club dinners from 2003, 2007-2008 and 2010 are also documented in video files in this series. These files were removed from storage media found within Thomas's papers.
