Scope and Content Note

The papers of Alan Greenspan span the years 1914-2009 with the bulk of the material dating from 1948 to 2009. The collection documents the career of Alan Greenspan as an economist in both the private and public sector. It contains the following series: [Federal File](#), [Speeches](#), [Engagements](#), [Correspondence](#), [Townsend-Greenspan and Company](#), [The Age of Turbulence](#), [Personal File](#), [Closed](#), [National Security Classified Information](#), and [Oversize](#).

The collection's series are listed and briefly described below. A fuller description of each series and a list of its contents can be accessed in the series descriptions within the container list.

The [Federal File](#) contains various items related to Greenspan's membership of several federal commissions and boards, including his chairmanship of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve.

The [Engagements](#) series documents Greenspan's travel arrangements and itineraries to various conferences and public events.

The Correspondence series features correspondence between family, friends, and colleagues primarily following Greenspan's retirement from public service.

The Federal File series contains materials that reflect Greenspan's career in the federal government. Most materials originate from his chairmanship of the Council of Economic Advisers and the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve, as well as his membership on the President's Commission on Financial Structure & Regulation. The series documents Greenspan's membership in these bodies through certificates of appointment, swearing-in ceremony materials, and security clearance packets. An assortment of briefing books, staff memoranda, and reports also illustrate some of the issues and topics tackled by these three bodies during Greenspan's tenure. Documentation of the activities of the other boards and commissions listed in this series is sparse; materials consist entirely of Greenspan's certificates of appointment and ceremonial items from the signing of the 1983 Social Security Act amendments.

The Speeches series documents Greenspan's public pronouncements regarding economic theory and practice and the status of the U.S. and global economies, delivered to various committees of the U.S. government and a variety of economics conferences, retreats, meetings, and events. The chronological file within this series documents Greenspan's public formal and informal remarks from his time as chairman of the Federal Reserve as well as at conferences and events as a member of the President's Council of Economic Advisors and as president of Townsend-Greenspan & Co. The thematic file within this series documents remarks delivered at individually identified or oft-repeated events. The bulk of the material in the thematic file consists of statements delivered to Federal Reserve employees on the occasions of special events and campaigns. BOX 25-37

Engagements, 1972-2006

The Engagements series documents the public appearances and trips Greenspan made while serving as chairman of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve, including conferences, dinners, meetings, and retreats. Correspondence, 1972-2008

The Correspondence series documents Greenspan's personal and professional activities. It includes correspondence with officials of the U.S. and various European and Asian governments. The bulk of the material spans 2006-2007.

The chronological file within this series includes correspondence exchanged between Greenspan and his family, friends, acquaintances, public figures, and government officials

on topics unrelated to his management of the Federal Reserve. Frequent and notable correspondents include Stephen G. Breyer, Gordon Brown, Sara M. "Sallie" Eccles, Katharine Graham, Kay Bailey Hutchison, Edward Watson Kelley, Mervyn A. King, John D. Rockefeller IV, Donald Rumsfeld, Margaret Thatcher, and Barbara Walters. The thematic file within this series consists of correspondence separated by Greenspan and his office according to event, theme, or special correspondent. Related material can also be found within the chronological file. Included are substantive correspondence from President Gerald R. Ford. Material types include letters, postcards, emails, fan mail, invitations, cards, notes, and attached reference material. Arranged chronologically and thematically.

BOX 49-124

Townsend-Greenspan and Company, 1950-1987

This series contains the working files from Alan Greenspan's consulting firm, Townsend-Greenspan & Co. The firm provided economic forecasting and analysis for various clients and operated until Greenspan's nomination to the Federal Reserve Board of Governors in 1987. The largest portion of this series are the publications the firm created throughout its history, including money market reports, business outlooks, and short-term projections. Townsend-Greenspan & Co. provided consultation to a variety of clients included in this series, such as the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) for which the firm studied the potential loss of album sales due to the effects of home audio recording. Other clients include the Wickes Companies, Inc., Lincoln Savings & Loan Association, the Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA), and the American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP). Additional material included in this series are speeches and transcripts from public speaking engagements and data created and collected related to imports and exports, budget modeling, and corporate taxes. Material types include publications, data, speeches, transcripts, administrative files, and reports. Arranged alphabetically by subject or type of material.

BOX 124-159

The Age of Turbulence, 1941-2008

The Age of Turbulence series contains the drafts and notes from Alan Greenspan's autobiography. Published in 2007, the book spans Greenspan's life and career and also offers his insight on the future of the United States and global economy. The series contains primarily drafts and edits made both by chapter and chronologically. Greenspan received assistance in writing *The Age of Turbulence* from his collaborator Peter Petre, who fact-checked, advised, and edited the book. Petre also conducted interviews with Greenspan and his wife, Andrea Mitchell. Petre's contributions are reflected in the collaborator files in this series. Additional material in this series includes administrative files involving the publication of *The Age of Turbulence*, subject files used as reference, and publicity following the book's publication. Material types include drafts, interviews, reference material, notes, subject files, and administrative files. Arranged alphabetically by type of material.

BOX 159-169

Personal File, 1914-2009

The Personal File series contains materials that reflect Greenspan's personal life, daily activities, and professional endeavors, the bulk of which date from the mid-1970s until 2009. The series includes material related to Greenspan's professional life, including contact cards, documentation of his participation on various boards, and his writings published in academic and economic journals and magazines. Notes from interviews with journalists as well as clippings from newspapers, popular magazines, and economic journals that feature Greenspan illustrate his public profile as an economist. Other materials

provide a glimpse into Greenspan's personal life, such as writings and research completed during graduate school, financial material, awards and diplomas, photographs of Greenspan at the Economic Club of New York, and miscellaneous materials related to his mother, club membership, and donations. Daily schedules and calendars compiled by his assistants during his early years as Chair of the Federal Reserve appear to document activities related to both his professional and personal life.

Material types include contact cards; graduate schoolwork such as dissertation drafts and related research, writing, data sets, and calculations; selected financial materials such as receipts, paid bills, and balanced check books; interview notes and clippings that feature Greenspan; calendars and daily schedules; photographs; and awards and diplomas.
