## **Administrative History**

Teachers Guides to Television, an educational publication financed by the National Broadcasting Company (NBC), produced biannual issues from 1968 to 1985. Founded and directed by Edward Stanley and Gloria Kirshner Stanley, former NBC executives, the publication was targeted towards elementary educators and provided information on specially selected programming of educational value. It also suggested pre- and post-viewing lesson plans, supplied background information on highlighted programs, and provided guidelines for parents. Along with NBC-TV, the organization also coordinated "Parent Participation Television Workshops" across the country.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The congressional interviews of the Teachers Guides to Television span the years 1916-1977, with the bulk of the material dating from 1972 to 1973. The collection contains typed transcriptions of interviews conducted by Edward Stanley and Gloria Kirshner Stanley with members of the United States Congress including Robert Taft Jr., Jacob K. Javits, Shirley Chisholm, Herman Badillo, and Gerald R. Ford. Topics include their childhoods, education, political views, and advice for young adults seeking careers in public service. Also included in the collection are newspaper clippings, photographs, and printed matter related to New York City Public School 20, from which Jacob K. Javits graduated, and issues of the Teachers Guides to Television publications and related correspondence.
