**Summary:** Author. Correspondence, diaries, speeches, writings, scripts, drafts, journals, and photographs, in both physical and digital formats, documenting Wouk's personal life and career as a best-selling author of fiction and non-fiction. Physical materials also include financial and legal materials, travel files, articles, printed material, and memorabilia. Materials in digital format also include video and audio files.

## **Acquisition Information**

The papers of Herman Wouk were given to the Library of Congress by Wouk between 1995 and 2019.

## **Processing History**

The papers of Herman Wouk were arranged and described by Amanda Loeb with the assistance of Jake Bozza, Andrea Briggs, Melinda Friend, Nate Scheible, Annette Scherber, and Emilia Schrier from 2019 to 2021. Some items have undergone mold remediation. The finding aid was written primarily by Amanda Loeb and Emilia Schrier.

Digital files were received as part of the Herman Wouk Papers on a variety of storage media, each of which was assigned a unique digital ID number. Use the digital ID number to request access copies of the files associated with each media. A description of the standard processes taken on all born digital records can be found in the Processing History Note: Born Digital Collection Material at <https://hdl.loc.gov/loc/mss/eadmss.digital>. To recover the data from some optical disks, disk images of these media were created and the files were exported from the disk image. Disk images also were created from raw stream files extracted from 5.25" floppy disks. Staff also imaged damaged or corrupt media and extracted the files from the disk image. Audio files in .cda format were ripped to .wav format by staff during processing. Diary files were removed from digital ID sets in accordance with restrictions on the Herman Wouk Papers; access to diaries is restricted until 2039. The Manuscript Division retains a complete copy of all files in digital ID sets with diary files left in their original locations. Researchers can access these digital ID sets only by permission of the donor's designated representative. ## **Transfers**

Items have been transferred from the Manuscript Division to other custodial divisions of the Library. Sound discs, audiotapes, film reels, and videocassettes have been transferred to the Motion Picture, Broadcasting, and Recorded Sound Division. Some photographs, negatives, and albums have been transferred to the Prints and Photographs Division. A selection of Herman Wouk's personal library has been transferred to the Rare Book and Special Collections Division. All transfers are identified in these divisions as part of the Herman Wouk Papers. Patrons are encouraged to contact these divisions in advance of a research visit.

Access to digital content is available onsite only in the Manuscript Reading Room and requires advanced notice.

## National Security Classified Information

Government regulations control the use of national security classified items in this collection. Manuscript Division staff can furnish information concerning access to and use of classified material.

## Technical Requirements

Digital files were created in a Windows operating system, version is unknown. The content is primarily text files in .doc format. Image files in .jpg and .pdf formats, audio files in .wav format, and moving image files in .vob formats are also included. At the time of processing, content from 5.25" and some 3.5" floppy disks was not fully recoverable. Partial and/or unformatted text from the files can be viewed with a text editor such as Notepad.

## Digitized Content

Diary Volumes 1-88, commonplace book I, management summary record, and personal business summary journal were digitized by the donor prior to transfer of the physical diaries to the Library. The Library received scans as both TIFF files and PDF files. PDF files have been assigned digital ID numbers mss83183\_036\_002\_r through mss83183\_036\_091\_r. Access to diary scans is restricted until 2039.

## Microfilm

Microfilm on 1 reel was received as part of the papers of Herman Wouk and is listed and described in this finding aid. This microfilm is not available for interlibrary loan.

## Scope and Content Note

The papers of Herman Wouk (1915-2019) span the years 1920-2019, with the bulk of the material dating from 1934 to 2019. The collection documents Wouk's seven-decade career as a best-selling author of fiction and non-fiction, as well as his personal life and family relationships. The papers are primarily in English, with some Hebrew, Arabic, and Chinese. The collection is organized in ten series: [Correspondence](#), [Diaries \(Restricted\)](#), [Digital Files](#), [Personal File](#), [Speeches](#), [Interviews, and Lectures](#), [Stage and Screen](#), [Writings, Restricted](#), [National Security Classified Information](#), and [Oversize](#).

The collection documents Wouk's writing career chiefly from 1970 onward, focusing on his middle and later career, with less material related to his early writings. The material documents his entire writing process, from inspiration and

research, through drafting, revisions, editing, and publication. Writings, correspondence, and personal material demonstrate the extensive influence of Wouk's wife, Betty Sarah Wouk, in his literary, business, and personal decisions. She served as his literary agent for decades and advised and edited his writings at every stage of his process. The collection highlights Wouk's lifelong interest in the state of Israel, and includes material from several trips and extended stays, as well as correspondence with Israeli officials and residents. Correspondence, writings, and professional associations demonstrate his deep commitment to his Jewish faith and his efforts to reconcile the traditions of orthodox Judaism and modern life, which heavily influenced his writing. Writings and other material also reflect the influence of Wouk's World War II naval service and the effects of the Holocaust. Much of his personal material reflects Wouk's strictly regimented and disciplined approach to writing, finances, and physical health, and includes various types of diaries, journals, and workbooks.

The [Speeches, Interviews, and Lectures](#) series documents the speeches, interviews, lectures, extemporaneous remarks, and readings Wouk gave throughout the course of his career, the bulk of which date from 1955 to 2004.

The [Stage and Screen](#) series consists of scripts, screenplays, and treatments written or consulted on by Wouk for theatre, television, and film.

The [Writings](#) series documents Wouk's nearly seven-decade career as a best-selling author of fiction and non-fiction.

**Correspondence, 1941-2019**

The Correspondence series consists of Wouk's general and personal correspondence dating from 1941 to 2019. There is also some business correspondence, including exchanges with publishers, lawyers, and professional organizations. Correspondents are generally not members of Wouk's family. Some correspondence received while traveling is in the Travel Files within the Personal File series. Family correspondence is also arranged in the Personal File series. Correspondence pertaining to specific writings, scripts, or projects is arranged in the Stage and Screen or Writings series.

Material types include letters, telegrams, postcards, greeting cards, thank you notes, and emails.

**Diaries (Restricted), 1937-2014**

The Diaries (Restricted) series consists of diaries and journals kept by Wouk detailing his professional accomplishments, as well as personal, family, and historical events that occurred throughout his life. The series consists primarily of eighty-seven volumes of diaries dating from November 1937 to 2014. Wouk destroyed Volume 2, covering the period of February 1938 to August 1939, before transferring the diaries to the Library of Congress. From November 2005 to March 2012, Wouk switched from the traditional diary format to files labeled "Atzmi." These files are a briefer recording of notable occurrences, rather than a day-by-day running account. Wouk produced digital scans of his diaries for the Library of Congress in 2008, prior to the transfer of the physical volumes. The series also includes a commonplace book, financial journals, and travel logs.

Access to the Diaries series is restricted until 2039.

Material types include handwritten and typescript bound and loose volumes.

**Digital Files, 1980-2019**

The Digital Files series consists chiefly of text files, with some video, audio, and image files, created by Herman Wouk between 1980 and 2019. The content includes drafts, revisions, work journals, scripts, diary entries, correspondence, business files, memoranda, photographs, interviews, audio books, and miscellaneous writings and ideas. Wouk began using a personal computer for writing, business, and personal work as early as 1980. The earliest writing projects represented in the digital files are scripts for the miniseries War and Remembrance and chapter drafts for the novel The Hope. Wouk often used a system of saving all active files from a given time to a single disk, then beginning a new disk after filling the previous disk. These chronological disks, nos. 01-29, consist of drafts, work journals, correspondence, memoranda, business files, miscellaneous ideas, diaries, and other files. Access to diary files is restricted until 2039. Diary files have been removed from digital ID sets in accordance with the restriction. The Manuscript Division retains a complete copy of all files in digital ID sets with diary files left in their original locations. Researchers can access these digital ID sets only by permission of the donor's designated representative. For names of removed files, researchers can compare the original directory listing with the payload listing or see [Appendix: Restricted Digital Files](#).

Material types include text, video, audio, and image files.

Arranged alphabetically beginning with the chronological disks and thereafter according to the series from which the material was separated. File structure and order of the digital content within each digital ID set maintained as received.

**Personal File, 1920-2019**

The Personal File series contains family and personal correspondence, financial materials, awards and honors, biographical material, event files, charitable contributions, real estate documents, journals, memorabilia, travel files, and other materials that document Wouk's family relationships, personal achievements, and private life. Family correspondence, dating from 1939 to 2004, documents the close relationship with his mother, Esther Wouk, and brother, scientist and electrical engineer Victor Wouk. There are also letters between Herman Wouk and his wife, Betty Sarah Wouk. Other family correspondents include his sister, Miriam Sacks, Victor's wife, Joy, and his surviving children, Iolanthe Woulff (deadname Nathaniel Wouk) and Joseph Wouk. The series also documents Wouk's lifelong relationships with his alma mater, Columbia University, and the Library of Congress, including his receipt of the Library of Congress Lifetime Achievement and Living Legends awards. Other awards and honors include honorary degrees, certificates, and correspondence related to his Pulitzer Prize for Fiction awarded in 1952 for *The Caine Mutiny*. Charities represented include the Abe Wouk Foundation, established in memory of Wouk's first child, who drowned in a swimming pool before the age of five in 1951. Financial material includes a business diary, management journals, and numbered files. Numbered files include material related to contracts and negotiations for several publications and productions, chiefly *The Caine Mutiny* Court Martial and *Marjorie Morningstar*. There are also files related to Wouk's real estate holdings in California, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Washington, D.C. The travel files document Wouk's research trips, vacations, promotional tours, and other engagements in the United States, Israel, Australia, and other countries around the world. The China travel files document Wouk's invitation from the Chinese Writers Association to visit the country to lecture and meet with authors and historians. These files contain an unpublished diary of Wouk's 1982 travels in Israel, Hong Kong, and China between September and December, wherein he explores the parallels between Jewish and Chinese cultures, politics, and other personal observations. There is a small amount of material related to Wouk's United States Navy service, dating from 1941 to 1955.

Material types include correspondence, calendars, brochures, photographs, itineraries, business cards, financial and legal material, memoranda, architectural plans, photographs, writings, diaries, journals, notebooks, certificates, memorabilia, articles, and clippings.

**Speeches, Interviews, and Lectures, 1955-2004**

The Speeches, Interviews, and Lectures series documents the speeches, interviews, lectures, extemporaneous remarks, and readings Wouk gave throughout the course of his career, the bulk of which date from 1955 to 2004. This series includes drafts and published versions of speeches, interviews, lectures, and remarks, as well as supplemental correspondence, contracts, programs and other like material that detail his performances. Topics of speeches, interviews, and lectures often include Wouk's writings, professional career, Judaism and Jewish life, and warfare and the United States military.

Material types include drafts and published versions of speeches, interviews, and lectures, correspondence, contracts, notes, clippings, programs, photographs, and other travel and event planning documentation, such as guest lists and itineraries.

**Stage and Screen, 1941-2013**

The Stage and Screen series consists of scripts, screenplays, and treatments written or consulted on by Wouk for theatre, television, and film. Wouk adapted many of his novels for stage and screen. Among plays, the series includes files related to the attempted musical adaptation of his novel *Don't Stop the Carnival* with musician Jimmy Buffet from 1994 to



2001. Materials include contracts, correspondence, libretto drafts, marketing material, and work journals. Much of the correspondence concerns productions staged in Miami, Florida, and Nassau, Bahamas. The series also documents the play *The Caine Mutiny Court Martial*, dramatized by Wouk and adapted from his novel of the same name in 1953, and includes material on subsequent international and revival productions and television adaptations dating from 1954 to 2006. A small amount of material relates to film adaptations of *The Caine Mutiny*, *Marjorie Morningstar*, and *Slattery's Hurricane*. Among television productions, the series includes files related to the television mini-series *The Winds of War* and *War and Remembrance*, based on Wouk's novels, which aired on ABC in 1983 and 1988-1989, respectively. Files include promotion materials, publicity, reviews, research, and correspondence with producer and director Dan Curtis. The files primarily document the writing process, and include rough drafts, fragments, revisions, author approval review copies, and final shooting scripts. There is very little documentation of the production aspects of the project. Wouk's work journals further detail the writing process, describing his ideas, emotions, relationships with collaborators, and experiences working within the television industry. Wouk wrote the entire teleplay for *The Winds of War*, while Curtis and Earl W. Wallace wrote the bulk of the teleplay for *War and Remembrance*, with Wouk focusing on the more historical and Holocaust-related sequences.

Material types include writings, drafts, libretto, correspondence, work journals, notes, clippings, memoranda and notes, scripts, contracts, outlines, schedules, financial materials, and reviews.

#### **Writings, 1935-2019**

The Writings series documents Wouk's nearly seven-decade career as a best-selling author of fiction and non-fiction. Dating from 1940 to 2019, the series most prominently features works published or begun after 1970, including articles and essays, novels, non-fiction books, poetry, short stories, memoirs, and unpublished material. Works with the most material in the collection include *A Hole in Texas*, *The Hope*, *The Glory*, *Inside, Outside*, *The Winds of War*, and *War and Remembrance*. Files on individual titles include contracts, correspondence, marketing and promotional material, book design material, manuscript drafts, notes, publishing material, page and galley proofs, research files, reviews, and work journals. Wouk began the majority of his writing projects with a work journal, an often daily account of his writing process, detailing his ideas, inspiration, research methods, character development, progress, challenges, emotions about a project, and how life events influenced his writing. His most frequent subjects included World War II, the history of Israel, and Judaism. Manuscript drafts refer to typescript, handwritten, complete, or incomplete drafts that preceded the production of page and galley proofs. Within manuscript drafts, Wouk designated some files as discards, fragments, scraps, and roughs. Drafts went through multiple revisions, and Wouk often sent drafts to consulting experts for comments. He conducted extensive research for his writings, particularly for historical novels *The Winds of War*, *War and Remembrance*, *The Hope*, and *The Glory*. In the case of *The Winds of War* and *The Hope*, the scope of research and the subject matter proved too great for one book, prompting Wouk to write sequels to each. Much of the material related to *The Hope* and *The Glory* cannot be attributed to one book over the other, and is arranged and described together. Correspondence related to Wouk's writings includes consultation with historians, military officers, scientists, journalists, and other subject matter experts.

There is also correspondence with publishers, researchers, editors, and readers.

Access to the manuscript drafts and work journals for *Inside, Outside* is restricted until 2039.

Material types include articles, clippings, essays, contracts, correspondence, drafts, notes, memoranda, journals, outlines, poems, short stories, page and galley proofs, and research files.

The content includes drafts, revisions, work journals, scripts, diary entries, correspondence, business files, memoranda, photographs, interviews, audio books, and miscellaneous writings and ideas. Wouk began using a personal computer for writing, business, and personal work as early as 1980. The earliest writing projects represented in the digital files are scripts for the miniseries War and Remembrance and chapter drafts for the novel The Hope. Wouk often used a system of saving all active files from a given time to a single disk, then beginning a new disk after filling the previous disk. These chronological disks, nos. 01-29, consist of drafts, work journals, correspondence, memoranda, business files, miscellaneous ideas, diaries, and other files. Access to diary files is restricted until 2039. Diary files have been removed from digital ID sets in accordance with the restriction. The Manuscript Division retains a complete copy of all files in digital ID sets with diary files left in their original locations. Researchers can access these digital ID sets only by permission of the donor's designated representative. For names of removed files, researchers can compare the original directory listing with the payload listing or see <a href="#">Appendix: Restricted Digital Files</a> . Material types include text, video, audio, and image files. Arranged alphabetically beginning with the chronological disks and thereafter according to the series from which the material was separated. File structure and order of the digital content within each digital ID set maintained as received.

**Personal File, 1920-2019**

The Personal File series contains family and personal correspondence, financial materials, awards and honors, biographical material, event files, charitable contributions, real estate documents, journals, memorabilia, travel files, and other materials that document Wouk's family relationships, personal achievements, and private life. Family correspondence, dating from 1939 to 2004, documents the close relationship with his mother, Esther Wouk, and brother, scientist and electrical engineer Victor Wouk. There are also letters between Herman Wouk and his wife, Betty Sarah Wouk. Other family correspondents include his sister, Miriam Sacks, Victor's wife, Joy, and his surviving children, Iolanthe Woulff (deadname Nathaniel Wouk) and Joseph Wouk. The series also documents Wouk's lifelong relationships with his alma mater, Columbia University, and the Library of Congress, including his receipt of the Library of Congress Lifetime Achievement and Living Legends awards. Other awards and honors include honorary degrees, certificates, and correspondence related to his Pulitzer Prize for Fiction awarded in 1952 for *The Caine Mutiny*. Charities represented include the Abe Wouk Foundation, established in memory of Wouk's first child, who drowned in a swimming pool before the age of five in 1951. Financial material includes a business diary, management journals, and numbered files. Numbered files include material related to contracts and negotiations for several publications and productions, chiefly *The Caine Mutiny Court Martial* and *Marjorie Morningstar*. There are also files related to Wouk's real estate holdings in California, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Washington, D.C. The travel files document Wouk's research trips, vacations, promotional tours, and other engagements in the United States, Israel, Australia, and other countries around the world. The China travel files document Wouk's invitation from the Chinese Writers Association to visit the country to lecture and meet with authors and historians. These files contain an unpublished diary of Wouk's 1982 travels in Israel, Hong Kong, and China between September and December, wherein he explores the parallels between Jewish and Chinese cultures, politics, and other personal observations. There is a small amount of material related to Wouk's United States Navy service, dating from 1941 to 1955.

Material types include correspondence, calendars, brochures, photographs, itineraries, business cards, financial and legal material, memoranda, architectural plans, photographs, writings, diaries, journals, notebooks, certificates, memorabilia, articles, and clippings.

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The Writings series documents Wouk's nearly seven-decade career as a best-selling author of fiction and non-fiction. Dating from 1940 to 2019, the series most prominently features works published or begun after 1970, including articles and essays, novels, non-fiction books, poetry, short stories, memoirs, and unpublished material. Works with the most material in the collection include *A Hole in Texas*, *The Hope*, *The Glory*, *Inside*, *Outside*, *The Winds of War*, and *War and Remembrance*. Files on individual titles include contracts, correspondence, marketing and promotional material, book design material, manuscript drafts, notes, publishing material, page and galley proofs, research files, reviews, and work journals. Wouk began the majority of his writing projects with a work journal, an often daily account of his writing process, detailing his ideas, inspiration, research methods, character development, progress, challenges, emotions about a project, and how life events influenced his writing. His most frequent subjects included World War II, the history of Israel, and Judaism. Manuscript drafts refer to typescript, handwritten, complete, or incomplete drafts that preceded the production of page and galley proofs. Within manuscript drafts, Wouk designated some files as discards, fragments, scraps, and roughs. Drafts went through multiple revisions, and Wouk often sent drafts to consulting experts for comments. He conducted extensive research for his writings, particularly for historical novels *The Winds of War*, *War and Remembrance*, *The Hope*, and *The Glory*. In the case of *The Winds of War* and *The Hope*, the scope of research and the subject matter proved too great for one book, prompting Wouk to write sequels to each. Much of the material related to *The Hope* and *The Glory* cannot be attributed to one book over the other, and is arranged and described together. Correspondence related to Wouk's writings includes consultation with historians, military officers, scientists, journalists, and other subject matter experts. There is also correspondence with publishers, researchers, editors, and readers.

Access to the manuscript drafts and work journals for *Inside*, *Outside* is restricted until 2039. Material types include articles, clippings, essays, contracts, correspondence, drafts, notes, memoranda, journals, outlines, poems, short stories, page and galley proofs, and research files.
