Summary: Billy May (1916-2004) was an American arranger, composer, musician, and bandleader. The collection chiefly consists of holograph or photocopied manuscript scores, parts, lead sheets, and manuscript sketches. Additional materials include printed scores, part changes, film cues, and a handful of counterpoint exercises.

1938	Meets Charlie Barnet and begins writing arrangements for him on a weekly basis, including the hit <i>Cherokee</i>
1939 August	Charlie Barnet hires him to play trumpet with his band on a permanent basis
1940-1942	Joins the Glenn Miller band and delivers his first trumpet solo on <i>I Dreamt I Dwelt In Harlem</i>
1944	Writes arrangements for Frank Sinatra's <i>Your Hit Parade</i> and for the Phil Harris band on <i>The Jack Benny Show</i>
	Begins career as a recording arranger/conductor
1944-1946	Plays on the <i>Red Skelton Show</i> under Ozzie Nelson and works with John Scott Trotter on Bing Crosby's <i>Kraft Music Hall</i>
1946-1950s	Works with Alan Livingston at Capitol Records to produce recordings for children, including the hit tune <i>I Taut I Taw a Puddy Tat</i>

Scope and Content Note

The Billy May Arrangements principally consist of holograph or photocopied manuscript scores, parts, lead sheets, and sketches for works created between 1939 and 1995. Additional materials include printed scores, part changes, film cues, and a handful of counterpoint exercises. Although May worked almost exclusively as an arranger for long periods throughout his career, he did compose original music, and several of these titles are represented in this collection. *I Taut I Taw a Puddy Tat*, *Front Page Rag*, and his film score for *Sergeants Three* are notable examples. Titles and cross-references are arranged alphabetically and standardized according to Jack Mirtle's *The Music of Billy May: a Discography* (1998). Part sets are complete unless indicated otherwise.
