**Summary:** Arnold Schoenberg (1874–1974) was a composer, music theorist, and educator known for developing the twelve-tone compositional technique. He was also a member of the Second Viennese School, along with Alban Berg and Anton Webern. The Arnold Schoenberg Correspondence and Other Papers consists chiefly of holograph and typescript correspondence between Schoenberg and other composers, conductors, organizations, record labels, music publishers, and family members. The collection also includes a small amount of clippings, programs, photographs, receipts, and other papers.

Wayne Shirley processed the Arnold Schoenberg Correspondence and Other Papers in the 1980s with assistance from Kate Rivers. The collection was prepared for the Arnold Schönberg Center's digitization project in 2003. Jane Cross, Anthony Edwards, and Rachel McNellis coded the finding aid in 2021.

## Transfers

Wire and disc recordings have been transferred to the Library of Congress Motion Picture, Broadcasting, and Recorded Sound Division, where they are identified as part of the Arnold Schoenberg Audio Materials (MAVIS collection no. 6591). These recordings preserve drafts of letters, a few lectures, a radio talk delivered in 1949, and a 1931 performance of Variations for Orchestra, op. 31.

## Scope and Content Note

The Arnold Schoenberg Correspondence and Other Papers spans the years 1894 to 1959, with the majority dating from the 1920s to the 1940s. The collection largely consists of Schoenberg's professional and personal [Correspondence](#) with notable musical figures, organizations, and family members. The Correspondence from Schoenberg subseries encompasses letters that Schoenberg wrote to composers, conductors, organizations, and family members. The Correspondence to Schoenberg and His Estate subseries contains letters that composers, conductors, organizations, and family members wrote to Arnold Schoenberg and those responsible for his estate. These two subseries include a significant amount of correspondence with Schoenberg's teacher, Alexander Zemlinsky, and his students Alban Berg and Anton Webern. The [Clippings and Miscellany](#) series contains clippings, many of which document the premieres for *Pierrot Lunaire* in 1912 and *Gurre-Lieder* in 1913, as well as programs, photographs, receipts and other papers.

This subseries consists of holograph and typescript letters that Schoenberg wrote to other musicians, organizations, record labels, music publishers, and family members.

Composers, music theorists, and conductors comprise the majority of correspondents.

These include his teacher Alexander Zemlinsky, as well as his students Alban Berg, Anton Webern, Hans Eisler, Dika Newlin, and brother-in-law Rudolf Kolisch. Other recipients include composers who incorporated Schoenberg's compositional techniques into their work, such as Henry Cowell, Luigi Dallapiccola, Ernst Krenek, René Leibowitz, and Edgar Varèse. Conductors who programmed his works are also well represented and include Wilhelm Furtwängler, Hans Kindler, Otto Klemperer, Serge Koussevitzky, Dmitri Mitropoulos, Fritz Reiner, Nicolas Slonimsky, and Leopold Stokowski. Béla Bartók, Pablo Casals, Elizabeth Sprague Coolidge, Aaron Copland, and Alma Mahler are among the many additional musicians with whom he corresponded.

These materials also offer insight into Schoenberg's associations with music societies and foundations, such as the Akademie der Künste in Berlin, American Federation of Musicians, American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP), Guggenheim Foundation, and the International Society for Contemporary Music. Finally, it includes correspondence with numerous major symphony orchestras in the United States and various universities where he lectured, such as the University of Southern California, the University of California, Los Angeles, and the University of California, Berkeley.

In addition to his professional associations, these materials document Schoenberg's familial relationships, including those with his first wife Mathilde, second wife Gertrud, son Georg, mother Pauline, brother Heinrich, and his cousin Arthur Schoenberg. Physicist Albert Einstein and expressionist painter Wassily Kandinsky are among other notable correspondents.

**Correspondence to Schoenberg and His Estate, 1894-1959**

This subseries consists of holograph and typescript letters that other musicians, organizations, record labels, music publishers, and family members wrote to Schoenberg.

The vast majority of correspondents are composers, conductors, theorists, and other musicians. Substantial quantities of letters are present from his students Alban Berg, Hanns Jelinek, Anton Webern, Dika Newlin, and Erwin Stein, as well as his teacher Alexander Zemlinsky. There is also material from composers who built upon Schoenberg's compositional methods, such as Ferruccio Busoni, Louis Gesensway, and Oskar Posa.

Schoenberg corresponded with Les Six members Arthur Honegger, Darius Milhaud, and Francis Poulenc. Additional notable correspondents include composers Leonard Bernstein, Ernest Bloch, Carlos Chavez, Reinhold Gliere, Paul Hindemith, Erich Korngold, Gustav Mahler, Maurice Ravel, Gunther Schuller, Igor Stravinsky, and Richard Strauss. The materials also contain letters from conductors Walter Damrosch, Vladimir Horowitz, Hans Richter, Nikolai Sokoloff, and Arturo Toscanini.

There is a large amount of correspondence with music societies and educational institutes with which Schoenberg was associated. Of note are the Akademie für Musik und darstellende Kunst (Academy for Music and the Performing Arts) in Vienna, where he taught music theory and composition, the Verein für musikalische Privataufführungen (Society for Private Musical Performances), which he founded to provide rehearsals for modern works in Vienna, and the Allgemeiner Deutscher Musikverein (General German Music Association) that Franz Liszt and Franz Brendel founded in 1861. Additional societies include the American Academy of Arts & Letters, the American Composers' Alliance, and the Koussevitzky Music Foundation. There is also correspondence with record labels, music publishers, and symphony orchestras.

Finally, this series includes a significant amount of correspondence with his son-in-law, music editor and theorist Felix Greissle, his wife Gertrud, and their two sons Arnold and Herman.

The materials also contain letters from conductors Walter Damrosch, Vladimir Horowitz, Hans Richter, Nikolai Sokoloff, and Arturo Toscanini.

There is a large amount of correspondence with music societies and educational institutes with which Schoenberg was associated. Of note are the Akademie für Musik und darstellende Kunst (Academy for Music and the Performing Arts) in Vienna, where he taught music theory and composition, the Verein für musikalische Privataufführungen (Society for Private Musical Performances), which he founded to provide rehearsals for modern works in Vienna, and the Allgemeiner Deutscher Musikverein (General German Music Association) that Franz Liszt and Franz Brendel founded in 1861. Additional societies include the American Academy of Arts & Letters, the American Composers' Alliance, and the Koussevitzky Music Foundation. There is also correspondence with record labels, music publishers, and symphony orchestras.

Finally, this series includes a significant amount of correspondence with his son-in-law, music editor and theorist Felix Greissle, his wife Gertrud, and their two sons Arnold and Herman.
