Summary: Alexander Zemlinsky was an Austrian composer, conductor, pianist, and educator whose students included Arnold Schoenberg, Alban Berg, Erich Wolfgang Korngold, Alma Mahler, and Anton Webern. The collection consists of holograph music manuscripts for nearly all of Zemlinsky's repertoire, as well as some printed music. Other materials include manuscript and printed music by other composers, personal papers, correspondence, and writings by others.

1895-1896	Conducted the orchestra Polyhymnia, in which Schoenberg played cello
1895-1897	Taught Arnold Schoenberg (1874-1951)
1896	Clarinet Trio, op. 3, published by Nikolaus Simrock at Brahms's recommendation
1900	Opera <i>Es war einmal...</i> premiered by Gustav Mahler at the Vienna Hofoper
1900	Entered into a brief romantic relationship with his student Alma Schindler, who married Gustav Mahler in 1902
1900-1904	Served as Kapellmeister at both the Carltheater and the Theater an der Wien in Vienna
1901 October	His sister Mathilde Zemlinsky (1877-1973) married Arnold Schoenberg
1903	Taught Alban Berg and Anton Webern at the Schwarzwald School
1904-1905	Co-founded the Vereinigung schaffender Tonkünstler (Society for Creative Musicians) with Schoenberg for the promotion and performance of new music
1906-1907	Conducted the Volksoper in Vienna
1905 January 25	World premiere of his orchestral fantasy <i>Die Seejungfrau (The Mermaid)</i> in Vienna, during a concert at which Schoenberg's <i>Pelleas und Melisande</i> was also first performed

Scope and Content Note

The Alexander Zemlinsky Music Manuscripts and Other Papers spans the years 1887 to 1939 and contains music, personal papers, correspondence, and writings. The majority of these materials are concentrated between 1887 to 1899. Holograph and printed music for Zemlinsky's operas, ballets, dramatic works, songs, chamber music, and orchestral works comprise the [Music by Zemlinsky](#) series. [Music by Other Composers](#) includes manuscript and printed music for the works of Rudolf Beck, Digby La Touche, Franz Schubert, and Hugo Wolf, among others. Zemlinsky's [Personal Papers](#) include a diploma, awards, a program, and additional papers related to his life. [Correspondence](#) in the collection consists of letters to both Alexander and Louise Zemlinsky from Arnold Schoenberg's sister Otilie Blumauer-Felix, August Förster, Oskar Kokoschka, and Bernhard Schuster, as well as other prominent artists and musicians. A small series of [Writings by Others](#) contains typescript works by Hanns Heinz Ewers and Arnold Schoenberg, as well as annotated cast lists for various opera productions.

Music by Zemlinsky, 1887-1939

This series chiefly contains Zemlinsky's holograph full scores, piano-vocal scores, parts, fragments, and sketches. Many of these materials are annotated. The music for his operas is voluminous and includes manuscript materials for *Sarema*, *Es war einmal...*, *Eine florentinische Tragödie*, *Kleider machen Leute*, *König Kandaules*, *Der Kreidekreis*, *Der Zwerg*, and his unfinished work *Die heilige Vitalis*. Other notable dramatic works include incidental music for Shakespeare's *Cymbeline*, the pantomime *Ein Lichtstrahl*, and his ballets *Das gläserne Herz* and *Der Triumph der Zeit*.

In addition to Zemlinsky's stage works, the collection contains music for notable vocal works such as his Six Songs for Middle Voice and Orchestra, op. 13 (Maeterlinck Songs), his cantata *Die Feier der Tonkunst*, and settings for Psalms 13, 23, and 83. Materials for notable orchestral works, such as *Die Seejungfrau* and *Lyrische Symphonie*, are also present.

This finding aid uses a standardized title for each work whenever possible. When a composition has a distinctive, alternate title written on the score, it is indicated immediately below the standardized title for the piece.

An "O" followed by a number refers to the ordering system that Lawrence A. Oncley used in "The Works of Alexander Zemlinsky: A Chronological List," *Notes* 34, no. 2 (December 1977): 291-302. The lack thereof indicates that the work is not included in Oncley's inventory.

BOX 27

Music by Other Composers, 1897 and undated

This series consists of both published and manuscript music dating from the late-nineteenth to the early twentieth centuries. Significant items include manuscript scores of eight songs by Rudolf Beck, Hugo Wolf's song "Dass doch gemalt," and an incomplete manuscript vocal score for Act 2 of Digby La Touche's *Themidor*. Additionally, the verso of a manuscript score for Guthberg and Jakomann's (?) song "Eierpunsch" contains an unidentified sketch by Zemlinsky.

Personal Papers, 1890-1936

This series consists of various documents related to Zemlinsky's life, including his 1909 diploma from the Vienna Konservatorium der Gesellschaft der Musikfreunde (Conservatory of the Society of Friends of Music) and a certificate from his induction as an honorary member of Der Deutsche Männergesangverein (The German Male Choral Society) in 1921.

This series consists of assorted writings, most of which are undated, except for an 1896 edition of the newspaper *Wiener Punsch* for which Zemlinsky was a corresponding editor. Other items include a copy of Arnold Schoenberg's *Harmonielehre*, a typescript carbon copy of Hanns Heinz Ewers' dramatic play *Das Rosenfest der rheinischen Nonnen*, and annotated typescript cast lists for various opera productions.
